Dr. Yaara Barden, USC Professor and AO Member, Contributes to the 7th edition of *Ingle's Endodontics*


The most recent edition of the classic textbook *Ingle's Endodontics*, edited by Ilan Rotstein and John I. Ingle has been released. This two volume edition,


Among the many distinguished contributors are faculty members from our division (Drs. Yaara Berdan, Rafael Roges, Jaydeep


